According to Wikipedia: The phrase sanctity of life refers to the idea that human life is sacred, holy, and precious. The sanctity of life is inherent as man cannot create life. Although the phrase was used primarily in the 19th century in Protestant discourse, since World War II the phrase has been used in Catholic moral theology and, following Roe v.
