My head a-pointin’ down.

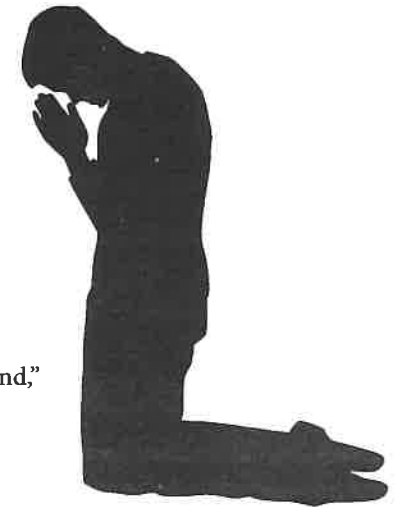
