It like new -

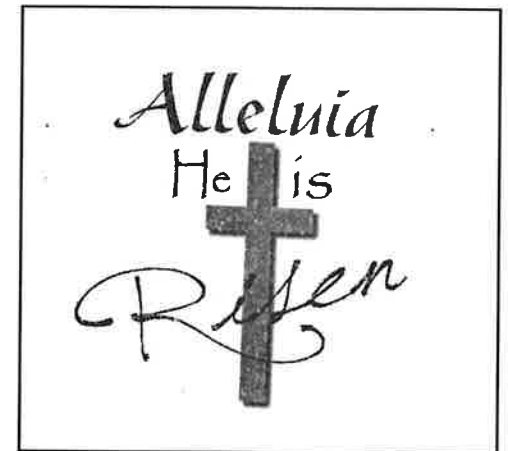
A heart that hopes
