I walked it long ago."

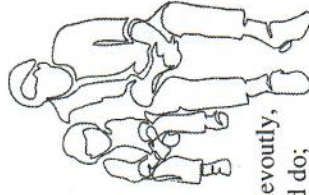
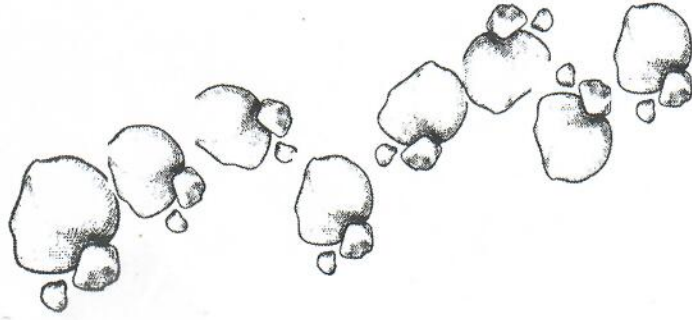
"But there is a cool green path," I said
