A SPECIAL CALLED BUSINESS MEETING: After much prayer (for almost 2 years now), soul searching, asking for direction from the Lord, and strong conviction, the Pulpit Committee has come to a unanimous recommendation to present Rev. Cody Fox to the church membership for a vote as our next pastor. The vote will be conducted next Sunday morning (April 30th) by a secret written ballot (Yes/No vote). We are herewith fulfilling our one-week notice requirement for the Special Called Business Meeting as stipulated in our By-Laws.

Per our By-Laws in Article 7, Section 7.03 - Voting at Business Meetings: "Voting at any church business meeting is limited to eligible members in good standing with the church who are physically present at the meeting. Only members of at least eighteen (18) years of age who are physically present at a duly called meeting of the church are entitled to vote. Proxy and absentee voting are not permitted, and any member who is undergoing church discipline at the time of a vote is not permitted to vote. A majority vote of the resident active membership present and voting will constitute the requisite number of votes for passage of motions. A three-fourths (3/4) majority vote of the resident active membership present and voting will constitute the requisite number of votes for passage."
