Next Sunday morning we will be having a **Communion Service** – Christ set before us the ordinance of the Communion Supper: he first instructed and observed it himself (Matthew 26:26-29; Mark 14:22-25); then he commanded the church to observe it (Luke 22:19-20; 1 Corinthians 11:24-34. Please take the time to read these versus before partaking of the Lord's Supper as there is a very serious warning contained in the scripture.

“Wherefore whosoever shall eat this bread, and drink this cup of the Lord, unworthily, shall be guilty of the body and blood of the Lord.”
1 Corinthians 11:27

Paul urged the Corinthians to judge themselves so that they wouldn't be judged (vv.28, 31). And he pointed out that even the Lord's judgment was for their benefit (v.32). The Lord's Table will remain an opportunity and a danger until He comes (v.26). By the attitude of our hearts, we will either honor His death or do damage to His name. Before you celebrate the Lord's Supper, prayerfully examine yourself. Then, with a heart of gratitude, focus on His sacrifice for you.

The 7-Ups

1. **Wake Up!** Decide to have a good day. "This is the day which the Lord hath made; we will rejoice and be glad in it." Psalms 118:24
