There will be **NO** Mid-Week Worship Service Wednesday evening to accommodate those that may have travel plans or who will be cooking for their family Thanksgiving meal.

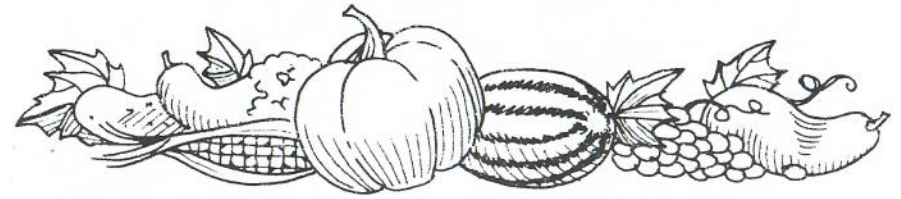
