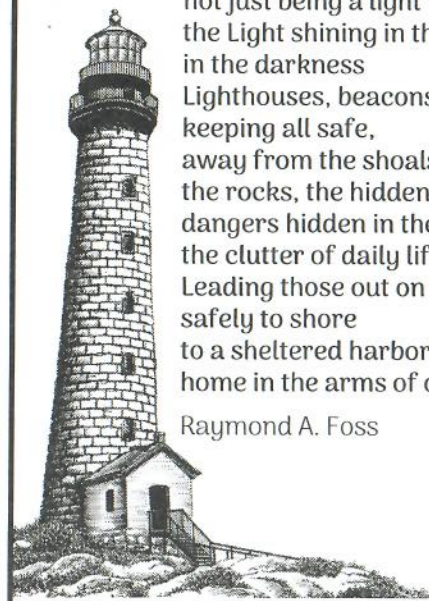
Dad's Hands
